Webinar overview: Comics Art & Information Architecture

Information architecture is the structural design of shared information environments, optimizing users' interaction with that content, and their context . Comic arts may be considered in light of information architecture in that it uses sequential frames, text and their "containers," and design conventions as information architectural "tools" to represent information and engage the user in interacting with it. This session explains information architecture, focusing on comic arts' features for representing and structuring knowledge, noting visual literacy. Next , applications of comic arts in education are described.
